



Conflict of Minerals Statement

Cherrytech Ltd acknowledges the Conflict Minerals Regulation and is committed to ethical business principles and the promotion of human rights. This includes responsible manufacturing of our products and responsible sourcing of materials. We require our suppliers to share in this commitment and have established Code of Conduct for Suppliers outlining our expectations in conducting business in a legal, ethical and responsible manner.

Our Supplier Code of Conduct requires our suppliers to ensure that the parts supplied meet the requirements of the regulation. That any of the minerals ie Tin, Tungsten, Tantalum and Gold used in the manufacture of these parts are DRC Conflict-Free. Conflict-free parts contain no metals derived from “Conflict Minerals” such that they directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups through mining or mineral trading in the Democratic Republic of Congo, or adjoining countries where human rights violations are alleged.
